From this term dinner money has increased to £12.50 per week (£2.50 per meal) and **should be paid in advance on Monday**. If you would prefer to pay for a block the cost for this halfterm is £70. Payments can be made via our online payment system – School Money – or via a bank card at the school office. Reminder - We require 2 weeks' notice if your child decides to change from dinners to sandwiches or vice versa.

Bank Holidays

Assessment Update

There are various statutory assessments which take place across the summer term: Y6 SATs week is w/c 8th May. Due to the extra bank holiday for the King's coronation, tests are scheduled Tuesday – Friday.

KS1 tests for Y2 pupils take place in May – the exact timings of these are determined by the school.

The Y1 phonics screening test will take place w/c 12th June.

The Y4 multiplication check will take place between $5^{th} - 16^{th}$ June.
