100% attendance last week



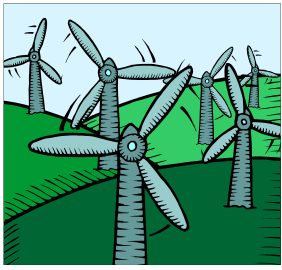
