Class 2 achieved the highest attendance last week with 98.9%. Super!

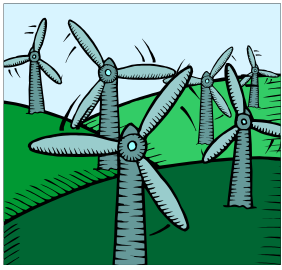
