Theme: Extreme Earth

Date: Spring 2025

Y4 – Class 3

Maths

We are completing multiplication and division this term. We will look at multiplying a 2-digit number by a 1 digit number. We will look at using what we know to solve calculations we don't know. We will be working on our times tables-3,4,8 and continuing to work on these on TT throughout the year.

In the fractions unit, we will begin with what a fraction is before comparing and ordering fractions with the same denominator. We will look at putting them on a number line before adding and subtracting fractions.

Science-

We will begin by looking at what a rock is before exploring the 3 different types of rocks; igneous, metamorphic and sedimentary. We will then compare and group rocks based on their appearance and also their physical properties.

RE

We will be aiming to answer the question: Could Jesus heal people? We will be looking at different miracle stories before concluding our opinions. We will also look at the Easter story.

History

The focus this term is geography. Children will complete their next history unit in the summer term.

<u>Art</u>

We will be focusing on our painting skills this first half term, using the artist Clara Peters to explore tints, shades and complementary colours.

Geography

Our topic this term is: Extreme Earth!
Children will be completing map work along with identifying key geographical features like mountain ranges and volcanoes around the world. Children will learn about volcanoes and how they are related to tectonic plates. We will also be thinking about why some people might pick to live near volcanoes. Children will also learn about earthquakes and what can cause them. What an exciting topic!

Computing

Over the term we are looking at programming using Scratch. Children will know how to explore a new programming environment. They will be able to use different commands to control a sprite. Children will be able to order a sequence of commands within a program.

English

This term in English we will continue to use talk for writing to support our learning. We will learn a text carefully and then use this to support our independent writing ideas. Over the next few weeks, we will be focusing on:

- Continuing to punctuate sentences correctly.
- Using fronted adverbials followed by a comma.
- Using inverted commas (speech marks) and other punctuation to punctuate direct speech.
- Checking that we are using Standard English in writing (we were/ we was, our/are, should have not should of)

Our class text is The Firework- Maker's Daughter. We will be reading this every day.
