

Literacy:

I can use phase 4 and some phase 5 phonemes in reading and writing. See additional bookmark.

To chunk longer words when reading. To segment words in syllables when spelling.

To sequence stories, inventing characters, settings, and alternative endings.

To retell well known stories, changing elements to make them their own.

I can use capital letters within sentences and for proper nouns.

To punctuate sentences using full stops, question marks and exclamation marks.

To join clauses using and, but, because,

To use and spell suffixes correctly, particularly focusing on -ed, -ing and -er.

I can use the prefix- un within my writing: un fair, un happy.

Physical Education:

**Science:**

To explore the changes and patterns within the environment: seasons: Spring and Summer.

We will investigate habitats further, comparing bug hunts with earlier in the year.

We will study plants and animals living in a range of habitats and learn about how they are adapted for life.

History

We will learn about the history of seaside resorts in England and how holidays have changed.

Geography: We will study the human and physical features of UK seaside towns. We will use compass directions to describe the location of features or routes on a map. We will use maps to locate seaside towns in relation to our own location and within the countries of the UK. We will recognise landmarks and physical features using aerial images and plan perspectives.

Mathematics:

I can count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number. I can recognise how many tens and ones are in a number.

I can count 1 more, less and 10 more and less from any number.

I can read, write and calculate addition and subtraction questions. Eg $23+5=$ or $39-2=$

Recalling number bonds to 20. $1+19=20$, $2+18=20$, $15+5=20$.

I can recall my doubles to 20, eg $10+10=20$, $4+4=8$, $2+2=4$.

I can recall opposing halves. Half of 20 is 10, half of 8 is 4. Etc.

I can count in 2s: 2,4,6,8,10,12,14,16,18,20.

I can count in 5s: 5,10,15,20,25,30,35,40,45,50.

I can count in 10s: 10,20,30,40, etc

I can read x as lots of and begin to work out simple multiplications. Eg: $2 \times 10=$

I can find quarters and halves of amounts and shapes.

I can measure weight using grams and kilograms, reading a scale.

I can measure length using cm, reading a scale.

I can tell the time: o'clock, half past. I can recognise what time it will be in 1 hour.

I can recognise coins: 1p,2p,5p,10p,20p,50p,£1, £2. I can add simple money.

Early Reading – Reading

Listen to your child read. Ask questions about the books they have read.

Before reading the book:

Can you point to the title?
What is the title of the book?
What do you think this story will be about?
What might happen in the story?
What does the blurb tell us about the story?

During the reading of the book:

What is happening in the pictures?
What has happened so far?
Is it what you expected to happen?
What might happen next?
How do you think the story might end? What sort of character is....?
Is he/she friendly/ mean/ nice...?

At the end of the book:

Did you like this book? Why?
What was your favourite part? Why?
What was the most interesting/ exciting part of the book?
Can you find it in the book?
